Sunday 18 September

- **Moderator's Prayer** | *The Moderator will be engaging in worship today at First Omagh Presbyterian Church. By prayer, encourage all those leading in worship across the Presbyterian Church in Ireland to be given the grace to declare the wonder of the gospel hope in the face of death.*

Monday 19 September

- **Moderator's Prayer** | *On the day of Her Majesty's funeral in Westminster Abbey, we acknowledge that the death of The Queen will be felt most keenly by her children, grandchildren and great grandchildren – let us remember them in their loss, praying they will find true peace at this time.*
- *Let each of us take a few moments to give thanks for God's grace seen in the life of Elizabeth II and pray that her influence will shape the future of the monarchy and encourage Christians everywhere to be bold for Jesus.*

Tuesday 20 September
