Sunday 13 April

- **Moderator** | *Pray for this week in the lead up to Easter when we focus on the death and resurrection of our Lord Jesus Christ. It's good to remember that faith, hope and love originate in our living Saviour.*
- **Worship: Palm Sunday** | *Ask that God would help us give voice to our worship of Jesus the humble servant King from hearts that delight in his love.*

Monday 14 April

- **Naomi Leremore, global mission worker, Kenya** | *Pray for Naomi as she settles back into life in Kenya and as she resumes her role with the PCEA TEE Programme following some weeks of deputation undertaken in Ireland.*
- **Hungarian Reformed Church** | *Give thanks for the clear and faithful witness to the Lord Jesus Christ by the Transcarpathian Reformed Church District (Ukraine) and pray for those in leadership and its members, that they would be granted resilience and hope in the face of the ongoing Ukraine – Russia war.*
